# EVENT GUIDE for the 46th Enduro "Novemberpokal" 02/03.11.2024

#### Race schedule:

Unlike last year, the November Cup will again be held as a classic enduro race this year. The European Championship with around 150 starters from 15 nations is hosted by MC Woltersdorf e.V..

The European Championship final begins with an opening ceremony on Friday, November 1st, 2024 at 6 p.m. on the town hall square in Woltersdorf. All nations and their participants will be introduced there. The mayor of Woltersdorf will open the event as patron.

The race starts with the first starting group on Saturday, November 2nd, 2024 at 8 a.m. on the town hall forecourt in Woltersdorf and ends around 4 p.m. On Sunday, November 3rd, 2024, the race also starts at 8 a.m. on the town hall forecourt.

In addition to the European Championship (3 laps of 60km with 3 special tests per lap), a national class of 2 laps of 60km with 3 special tests will also start on Saturday 2 November.

## **Route:**

The start is at the town hall square in Woltersdorf. From there it goes to the Maiwiese (ZK3, start/finish), further past Kranichsberg in the direction of Alt-Rüdersdorf/Herzfelde. Special test 1 (cross test approx. 4km) is at the Kesselsee in Rüdersdorf (Motodrom), followed by ZK1 (with service) and special test 2 (extreme test approx. 2km) also at the Kesselsee (Motodrom). Back along the break edge and through the open-cast mine, it continues to special test 3 (enduro test approx. 4km) on the MVS site. Then through the Stienitz forest behind Cemex to ZK2 (with service) at BVO. From there, the route leads through the Herzfelde industrial estate through the Grünheider forest back to the Maiwiese (ZK3 Paddock A with service).

A tip for all spectators. The most action will be seen at the special stages 1 + 2 at the Motodrom Kesselsee in Rüdersdorf! Cold and warm drinks and plenty of food will be provided there!
